

School drawing contest "Challenge clean soils"

The Spanish Society of Soil Science, through its Soil Education and Public Safety Section, organizes a school drawing contest within the framework of the celebration on 5 December of the World Soil Day. World Soil Day is promoted by the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations and the Global Soil Partnership with the collaboration of other national and international organizations. World Soil Day 2018 Theme: "Be the solution to soil pollution!".

This day we could explain the importance of protecting our soils from pollution to our students. There are many examples that can show them the risks of polluted soils for human health and the environment



Basic rules:

1. Topic: clean soils-soils without contaminants.
2. Colour or B/W drawings, collages, drawings with different soils, drawings made with digital tablets, etc.
3. Two drawings maximum per student will be accepted.
4. The drawings must be unpublished. Drawings that have been awarded in other contests or are currently participating in other similar events will not be accepted.
5. Categories: 5 (6-7 years, 8-9 years, 10-11 years, 12-14 years, 15-17 years).
6. Submission of drawings: Drawings will be sent from the school to edafoeduca@upv.es, with the following information: name and surname of the student, age of the student, name of the school, country of the school, contact person in the school.
7. Closing date for submission of drawings: 30 November 2018.
8. Prize: Certificate of participation and set of books. A winner for each category.
9. Jury: members of the SECS, teachers and artist chosen by the SECS.
10. The contest decision will be made public on 5 December 2018 on the website edafoeduca.es. At the same time, it will be communicated individually to the winners. The decision may not be appealed.
11. The date and place of delivery of prizes will be announced well in advance.
12. The drawings will remain the property of the SECS, which reserves the right to edit and use them, with non-profit use and always mentioning the author of drawings.
13. The SECS is not responsible for claims that arise for image rights and third parties.
14. Participation in the contest implies acceptance of these basic rules.
